RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GRANT, WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA, AUTHORIZING THE BUILDING OFFICIAL TO DIRECT LEGAL ACTION TO ABATE ZONING CODE VIOLATIONS

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Grant does hereby desire to establish and institute an efficient process for abating violations of the City's Zoning Code; and

WHEREAS, the City's Building Official is the individual charged with monitoring and reporting violations of the City's Zoning Code; and

WHEREAS, the City's Building Official is also engaged in the enforcement of the City's

Zoning Code; and

WHEREAS, the City's Building Official is in the position to determine whether a Zoning Code violation has been abated or whether it is necessary for the City to take legal action in order to fully abate the Zoning Code violation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to provide the Building Official with the authority to direct the City Attorney to initiate legal action whenever the Building Official has determined that legal action is necessary to fully abate a Zoning Code violation;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that by the City Council of the City of Grant, Washington County, Minnesota as follows:

1. The Building Official for the City of Grant is hereby authorized to direct the City Attorney to initiate legal action whenever it is deemed necessary, in the Building Official's sole discretion, for the purpose of abating a violation of the City's Zoning Code.
