**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING WASHINGTON COUNTY CONTINUE  
FUNDING THE 4-H PROGRAM THROUGH 2009**

**WHEREAS**, the 4-H Program is one of the largest youth programs in the United States; and

**WHEREAS**, 4-H promotes positive youth development and prevents problem behaviors throughout Washington County; and

**WHEREAS**, 4-H youth develop leadership skills and participate in community service projects while learning lifetime skills; and

**WHEREAS**, over 750 youth from Washington County participated in the club and site based programs last year; and

**WHEREAS**, over the past five years, 4-H youth have contributed more than 80,000 community service hours to Washington County residents, which is equivalent of \$1.4 million; and

**WHEREAS**, Washington County is proposing to discontinue funding this important youth program; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** THAT THE City of Grant requests Washington County Board support funding of the 4-H Program through 2009.
