Ordinance No. 2009-AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRANT, WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA, PROHIBITING PEDDLERS, SOLICITORS AND TRANSIENT MERCHANTS AND REGULATING NON-COMMERCIAL DOOR-TO-DOOR ADVOCATES

On August 4, 2009, the City of Grant adopted an ordinance prohibiting Peddlers, Solicitors and Transient Merchants from operating within the City and further establishing local regulations for the operation of Non-Comercial Door-to-Door Advocates (the "Ordinance"). The Ordinance prohibits the practice of going in and upon private reidences by Peddlers, Solicitors and Transient Merchants, not having been requested or invited to do so by the owner of the private residence. The Ordinance recognizes that Non-Commercial Door-to-Door Advocates may not be prohibited within the City, but places reasonable time, place and manner restrictions upon their operations. The Ordinance further repeals City of Grant Ordinance 2003-102 which previously allowed Peddlers, Solicitors and Transient Merchants to operate within the City upon receiving a license from the City.
